A BOTANICAL APPROACH TO LIVING ARCHITECTURE

At Paracelsus Gardens™, we approach gardens as architectural systems and integrated botanical architecture rather than ornamental landscapes.

Our work explores how living plants can become a structural component of space, shaping light, circulation, and daily experience through carefully designed botanical compositions.

Rooted in European design culture and reinterpreted through a contemporary, international lens, we design environments where the boundaries between interior and exterior dissolve naturally. Gardens are conceived as continuous living spaces — adaptable, modular, and designed to exist seamlessly indoors and outdoors, across a wide range of architectural contexts.

Beyond modular botanical walls, our work also encompasses the design of refined planters, material assemblies, and spatial compositions integrating vegetation as part of the architecture itself. Plants interact with wood, stone, metal, Corian, and mineral surfaces through systems and design solutions conceived for both interior and exterior environments, extending the perception of space and reinforcing a sense of continuity.

Our approach favors clarity, restraint, and longevity — creating living spaces that feel calm, meaningful, and deeply connected to everyday use, where nature is not added, but built in.

THE ATELIER

At the heart of Paracelsus Gardens™ lies The Atelier — a space dedicated to the design of botanical architecture.

Each project begins with an in-depth reading of space, light, materials, and use, where gardens are conceived as an integral part of the architectural composition rather than a decorative addition.

Drawing from European design culture and reinterpreted through a contemporary, international perspective, The Atelier develops bespoke concepts adapted to each context. Residential terraces, interior spaces, hospitality environments, or corporate settings are approached with the same attention to proportion, rhythm, and long-term coherence.

Plants are treated as a living material, selected for their structure, behavior, and sensory qualities, and composed in dialogue with wood, stone, metal, and mineral surfaces. The design process favors clarity and restraint, allowing vegetation to structure space, create intimacy, and support everyday use.

From early design phases to concept development, The Atelier acts as an interface between clients, architects, and local expertise, ensuring that each botanical project is both meaningful and enduring.

Through this approach, Paracelsus Gardens™ conceives gardens as enduring environments — adaptable, restrained, and deeply connected to the way architecture is lived.




WORKING WITH PARACELSUS GARDENS™
